2011 Season

All participants in the OVYL Field Hockey Program must read and sign the Code of Conduct. By signing this document, you acknowledge that you have read it, understand it and are willing to abide by the Code of Conduct. Play will not be allowed until a signed Code of Conduct is on file for each player in the current season.

Parents and Players Rules of Conduct:

1. As a parent, guardian or player, I understand that participants, parents and family members are representatives of the Oley Valley Youth League.
2. As a representative of the Youth League, I understand that it is my responsibility to exhibit good character and behavior at all times.
3. I understand that poor sportsmanship, foul language and berating of coaches or field judges will not be tolerated.
4. I understand that the goal of the OVYL Field Hockey program is to provide development of and opportunity for players of all ages and skill levels.
5. I understand that coaches do their best to provide equal playing/coaching time during all regular league games.
6. I will refrain from coaching from the sidelines and will provide words of encouragement to my daughter and her teammates.
7. I will refrain from speaking about other athletes and parents in a derogatory manner during games or practices.
8. I will encourage a positive attitude in my daughter and will not encourage a win-at-all-costs attitude.
9. I understand that coaches and field judges are volunteers. If I have a problem that I feel is not getting resolved, I will enlist the assistance of the field hockey commissioner and Youth League president.

I understand that violations of the above could result in being asked to leave an event or the facility.
